

Pilot Software Version 1 to 2 Quick Reference

This guide is to reference the normal “Day to Day” changes between Pilot Version 1 and Pilot Version 2. While there are more changes than on this list, these are the most used features. The setup options have been moved out of the normal day to day activities.

- **Changing Channels** – Tap a receiver. 4 options will appear
 1. **REMOTE** – Same as number pad in Version 1. Changes channel to the channel you input and send to the receiver.
 2. **GUIDE** - As you can see the Guide button is no longer at the top of the page. It is accessed through each receiver. That is so your cable/satellite receivers can have separate guides. You can change the channel for that receiver right from the guide by tapping on a show that is currently playing. In the guide the scroll has been changed to +/- and a number. The guide will jump that many channels in the guide. You now have a “remote” button that will act as described earlier. If you try to tune to a program that is not currently on it will create a reservation and appear at the top of that guide and an icon will appear on the receiver button on the main home page. To delete a reservation simply tap the show again.
 3. **FAVORITES** – If there are favorite channels set up this button will bring up a screen that only shows your favorite channels. Simply tap the desired favorite.
 4. **PREVIEW** – In most current locations this button will be “grayed” out and will not be available. It will only be available if there is a monitor/tv that is set up for previews. This is only set up by an installer.

- **Setting Favorites and Shortcuts**
 1. **Favorites** – Are now set in the “Options” tab. Simply tap add, edit or delete your favorites on the right hand side of the Home tab.
 2. **Shortcuts** – Are now accessed on the main tab called “TV Groups” This is where you can change several TV’s at once. This is set up on the Options/Preset Tabs. Please note you cannot set a preset without the correct amount of TAP.TV channels being assigned.

- Be aware there are many new features you may be interested in. Such as removing unused channels from the guide and adding favorite sports teams. (Options/Guide Options). Please look over the new Pilot 2.0 Manual for additional features that you have been asking for.
